

NEW ZEALAND LADIES HAIRDRESSING INDUSTRY –  
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

Dated 3/11/75

In the Industrial Court of New Zealand – In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Ladies Hairdressing Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 14th day of December 1973, and being recorded in the 73 Book of Awards 5631.

Whereas by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Industrial Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: And whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Ladies Hairdressing Industry Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Ladies Hairdressing Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 14th day of December 1973: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended by adding after the word “industry” in line 3 of subclause (c) of clause 10 (Proportion) the following words: “and who can satisfy the Local Commissioner of his or her competency”.

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
