Under the Industrial Relations Act 1973 REGISTERED COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT

In the matter of the Industrial Relations Act 1973; and in the matter of J. Wattie Canneries Limited, Gisborne Food Preserving Factory Employees Dispute of Interest between J. Wattie Canneries Limited, Gisborne Branch, and the New Zealand (except Northern (other than the factory of J. Wattie Canneries Limited at Gisborne) and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts) Food Processing, Chemical and Related Products Factory Employees Industrial Union of Workers.

The Industrial Commission, having before it the terms of a voluntary settlement arrived at in the above-mentioned dispute of interest and submitted or notified to the Commission pursuant to the provisions of section 65 of the Industrial Relations Act 1973, hereby registers as a collective agreement the terms, conditions, and provisions set out in the schedule hereto and orders:

1. That the said terms, conditions, and provisions shall be binding on the parties hereto; and

2. That the said parties shall respectively do, observe, and perform every matter and thing by this collective agreement required to be done, observed, and performed, and shall not do anything in contravention of this collective agreement but shall in all respects abide by and perform it.

THE J. WATTIE CANNERIES, GISBORNE, FOOD PRESERVING FACTORY EMPLOYEES INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

This voluntary settlement made in pursuance of the Industrial Relations Act 1973, section 65, this 17th day of October 1975 between J. Wattie Canneries Limited, Gisborne Branch (hereinafter called "the employer") and N.Z. (except Northern (other than the factory of J. Wattie Canneries Limited at Gisborne), and Otago and Southland Industrial Districts) Food Processing, Chemical and Related Products Factory Employees Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter called "the union") whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the said parties as set out in the following schedule:

SCHEDULE

PREAMBLE

1. Save as provided herein it is agreed that the provisions of the Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Nelson and Canterbury Food Preserving Factory Employees Collective Agreement for the time being in force, and any subsequent amendments thereto, or any award made or collective agreement duly entered into in substitution therefore shall stand as part of this collective agreement.

APPLICATION AND SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

2. This agreement shall apply to the employer and union so named.

TERM

3. This agreement, in so far as the provisions relating to the rates of wages to be paid are concerned, shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October 1975, and so far as all other provisions of the agreement are concerned, it shall come into force on the day of the date hereof; and this agreement shall continue in force until the 19th day of November 1976.
