**NEW ZEALAND PLASTERING INDUSTRY AMENDMENT OF
APPRENTICESHIP ORDER**

Dated 13/12/76

In the Industrial Court of New Zealand — In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Plastering Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 17th day of December 1968, recorded in 68 Book of Awards 2164.

Whereas by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Industrial Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: And whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Plastering Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Plastering Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 17th day of December 1968: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order be amended by deleting subclause (g) of clause 8 (Term of Apprenticeship) and substituting therefore the following new subclause:

“(g) Where a Local Committee is of the opinion that time served in a related or similar occupation prior to the date of application for engagement of an apprentice should be credited to the apprentice, it may fix the term of apprenticeship.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
