NEW ZEALAND MOULDING INDUSTRY – AMENDMENT TO APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

Dated 2/7/76

In the Industrial Court of New Zealand – In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of New Zealand Moulding Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 4th day of October 1967 and recorded in the 67 Book of Awards 2358.

Whereas by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: And whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Boilermaking and Moulding Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Moulding Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 4th day of October 1967, and recorded in 67 Book of Awards 2358: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended by:

1. Adding after the word “sickness” in the second line of subclause (d) of clause 8 (Term of Apprenticeship) the following words “or accident as defined by the Accident Compensation Act 1972.”

2. Adding after the word “sickness” in the first line of subclause (e) of clause 8 (Term of Apprenticeship) the following words: “or accident as defined by the Accident Compensation Act 1972.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
