## REGISTERED COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT

In the matter of the Industrial Relations Act 1973; and in the matter of the North Shore Ferry Employees Dispute of Interest between the North Shore Ferry Employees Industrial Union of Workers and the North Shore Ferries Limited and Waiheke Shipping Company Limited.

The Industrial Commission, having before it the terms of a voluntary settlement arrived at in the above-mentioned dispute of interest and submitted or notified to the Commission pursuant to the provisions of section 65 of the Industrial Relations Act 1973, hereby registers as a collective agreement the terms, conditions, and provisions set out in the schedule hereto and orders;

1. That the said terms conditions, and provisions shall be binding on the parties hereto; and

2. That the said parties shall respectively do, observe, and perform every matter and thing by this collective agreement required to be done, observed, and performed, and shall not do anything in contravention of this collective agreement but shall in all respects abide by and perform it.

In witness of the registration of this collective agreement the seal of the Industrial Commission has hereto been affixed and the President of the Commission has hereunto set his hand, this 16th day of June 1976.

TERMS OF VOLUNTARY SETTLEMENT UNDER  
SECTION 65 OF THE INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS ACT 1973

Voluntary settlement made this 31st day of May 1976 between the North Shore Ferry Employees Industrial Union of Workers, and the North Shore Ferries Limited and Waiheke Shipping Company Limited.

This collective agreement has the same terms and conditions as the award of the Industrial Commission dated 16 May 1975, save the following:

Clause 3 — Wages

(b) Diesel and steam tickets allowance — 33 cents per shift.	
(c) Cargo Handling allowance (daily) — 82 cents per day.	
(d) Cargo Handling allowance (maximum per week) — \$4.10 per week. Allowance for unloading milk on holidays etc. — \$3.28 per week. One day loading allowance — \$1.64 per week.	
(d) A.B. qualification allowance — \$4.50 per week.	
(e) Overalls and work conditions allowance — 8.2 cents per hour.	

Clause 21 — Term of Award

The rates of pay specified in Clause 3 as set out above shall be paid on the first day of the pay period commencing on or after the 27th day of November 1975 and shall continue in force until the 26th day of November 1976.
