## NEW ZEALAND PRINTING INDUSTRY – AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

Dated 31/3/77

In the Industrial Court of New Zealand — In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Printing Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 8th day of December 1975, recorded in 75 Book of Awards 10811.

Whereas by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948; the Industrial Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: and whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Printing Industry Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Printing Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 8th day of December 1975: and whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended by:

(1) Adding after "additional skills – flexographic" in the "Printing – Reelfed (Except Rotary Newspaper)" branch in the First Schedule (operations and skills) the following additional skills:

"Additional Skills - Rotogravure"

3:5:1 Principals and operation of gravure presses

3:5:2 Make-ready, preparation of cylinders, preparation and setting of doctor blades, registration, cylinder impression rollers, rewind equipment, web splicing equipment, heat for drying.

3:5:3 Principals of gravure cylinder-making. Care, maintenance and sto-

rage of cylinders.

- 3:5:4 Knowledge of packaging films, foil, polythene, paper, board and other materials used in gravure printing, lamination. Calculation of yields.
- (2) Altering the numbering of "Supplementary Skills Flexographic and Commercial Rotary" in the First Schedule (operations and skills) from 3:5:1-3:5:4 to 3:6:1-3:6:4.
- 2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
