NEW ZEALAND AIRCRAFT ENGINEERING INDUSTRY—AMENDMENT OF  
APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

Dated 8/11/77

In the Industrial Court of New Zealand — In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948: And in the matter of the New Zealand Aircraft Engineering Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 12th day of March 1973; recorded in 73 Book of Awards 1394.

Whereas by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Industrial Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: And whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Aircraft Engineering Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Aircraft Engineering Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 12th day of March 1973; And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended in the manner following:
  1. By deleting paragraphs (i), (ii) and (iii) of sub-clause (c) of clause 11 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following new paragraphs:
    - “(i) An apprentice passing the First Qualifying Examination of the New Zealand Trades Certification Board shall be entitled to \$1 a week in addition to the wages prescribed in this clause from the effective date of that pass.
    - (ii) An apprentice passing the Second Qualifying Examination of the New Zealand Trades Certification Board shall be entitled to \$2 a week in addition to the wages prescribed in this clause from the effective date of that pass.
    - (iii) An apprentice passing the Trade Certificate Examination of the New Zealand Trades Certification Board shall be entitled to \$3 a week in addition to the wages prescribed in this clause from the effective date of that pass.”
  2. By adding the following new paragraph (f) to clause 21 (Obligations of Employer):
    - “(f) The employer shall maintain a training record (as approved of by the New Zealand Committee) for each apprentice and that this training record shall be submitted to the local committee on request.”
2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
