NEW ZEALAND TIMBER INDUSTRY – AMENDMENT OF
APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

Dated 9/5/77

In the Industrial Court of New Zealand – In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948 and in the matter of the New Zealand Timber Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 16th day of December 1969, recorded in 69 Book of Awards.

Whereas by section 13(2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Industrial Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: and whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Timber Industry Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Timber Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 16th day of December 1969: and whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended by adding the following new subclause after subclause (c) of clause 10 (Wages):

“(d) In addition to the payments provided in subclauses (a) to (c) of this clause, the full service allowance provided of the New Zealand (Except Nelson and Westland) Timber Workers Award is to be paid to all apprentices subject to the terms and conditions of payment in force from the time being and from time to time as stipulated in the Award.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
