NEW ZEALAND PHOTO-ENGRAVING INDUSTRY — AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

Dated 8/2/79

In the Arbitration Court of New Zealand — In the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Photo-Engraving Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 8th day of December 1975, recorded in 75 Book of Awards 9077.

Whereas by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Arbitration Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: And whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Photo-Engraving Industry Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Photo-Engraving Industry Apprenticeship Order, dated the 8th day of December 1975: And whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: Now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended in the following manner:

By deleting the words "New Zealand" in the 8th line of sub-clause (a) of clause 7 and substituting therefor the work "Local".

By deleting sub-clause (c) of clause 10 (proportion) and substituting therefor the following subclause:

- "(c) An employer may employ apprentices in the proportion of not more than one to every two or fraction of two journey-persons employed by the employer."
- 2. That this order shall operate and take effect from the day of the date hereof.
