### REGISTERED COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT

# KILNCRAFT POTTERIES LIMITED EMPLOYEES — COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT — (VOLUNTARY)

This Collective Agreement made in pursuance of the Industrial Relations Act 1973 this 10th day of September 1979 between the New Zealand Labourers, General Workers and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers (Northern Branch) 1–3 Galatos Street, Newton, Auckland (Hereinafter called "the Union") of the one part, and Kilncraft Potteries Limited, Honan Place,

Avondale, Auckland 7. (hereinafter called "the Employer".) of the other part, whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. That the wages and classifications contained in the schedule hereto be binding upon the parties. All other conditions and stipulations not provided for in this Agreement shall operate as set out in the New Zealand Brick, Tile, Pottery and Porcelain Workers Award dated 28th day of May 1979.

The rates provided for in this Agreement will not be altered during its currency, except for the application of General Wage Order and/or Cost of Living Orders which shall be applied according to their tenor.

- 5. Exclusion of General Wage Order dated 3rd September 1979. These rates include the 4.5% General Wage Order applicable on 3rd September 1979.

### TERMS OF AGREEMENT

6. This agreement insofar as the rates of wages to be paid are concerned, shall come into force on the 10th day of September 1979 and shall continue in force until the 1st day of June 1980.
