COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT

1. Matters not Provided for — With the exception of the matters provided for specifically herein the terms and conditions of the N.Z. Engine Drivers Boiler Attendants Firemen and Greasers Award dated 23 June 1978 shall apply for the term of this Agreement.

2. Wages -

3. Service Allowance -

- 3.(a) After one year's continuous service with the same employer an adult worker shall be paid an allowance of 11 cents per hour
- (b) After two year's continuous service with the same employer an adult worker shall be paid a further 3 cents per hour making a total allowance of 14 cents per hour
- (c) After three year's continuous service with the same employer an adult worker shall be paid a further 2 cents per hour making a total allowance of 16 cents per hour
- (d) After four year's continuous service with the same employer an adult worker shall be paid a further 3 cents per hour making a total allowance of 19 cents per hour
- (e) After five year's continuous service with the same employer an adult worker shall be paid a further 2 cents per hour making a total allowance of 21 cents per hour

4. Lieu Bonus — All workers shall receive an in lieu bonus of 31.8 cents per hour. Such allowance shall be paid only for hours worked and shall continue to be paid at the same flat rate on overtime hours.

5. Hours of Work — As provided in Clause 2 of the N.Z. Engine Drivers Boiler Attendants Firemen and Greasers Award dated 23 June 1978 except that the shift allowance shall be \$2.62 per shift and the change over allowance shall be \$2.71.

6. General Conditions — As provided in Clause 11 of the N.Z. Engine Drivers Boiler Attendants Firemen and Greasers Award dated 23 June 1978 except that in Clause 11(g) of that document the rate shall be 44 cents.

7. Meal Money — As provided in Clause 13 of the N.Z. Engine Drivers Boiler Attendants Firemen and Greasers Award dated 23 June 1978 except that in Clauses 13(a) (b) (c) of that document the rate shall be \$2.10.

8. Dirt Money — As provided in Clause 14 of the N.Z. Engine Drivers Boiler Attendants Firemen and Greasers Award Dated 23 June 1978 except that in clauses —

12. Exclusion of Cost of Living Orders — The General Wage Order of the Court of Arbitration dated 3 July 1978 and all previous General Wage Orders, Cost of Living Orders and Cost of Living Allowances, have been incorporated into the rates and payments set out in this Agreement, and shall not be added to the payments shown.

13. Term of Agreement — This Agreement shall be deemed to have come into force on the 5th March 1979, and shall remain in force until 9 November 1979.
