NEW ZEALAND PHOTO-ENGRAVING INDUSTRY –
AMENDMENT OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

In the Arbitration Court of New Zealand – in the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand Photo-Engraving Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 8th day of December 1975 recorded in 75 Book of Awards 9077; as amended on the 8th day of February 1979 recorded in 79 Book of Awards 427.

Whereas by section 13(2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Arbitration Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: and whereas application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Photo-Engraving Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Photo-Engraving Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 8th day of December 1975, as amended on the 8th day of February 1979; and whereas the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: now, therefore, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, doth hereby order as follows:

1. That the said apprenticeship order shall be amended as follows:

(1) By deleting from subclause (a) of clause 1 (Industry to which Order applies) the bracketed words in –

subparagraph (i) – “(Photo-engraving and Photolithography)”

subparagraph (ii) – “(Photolithography)”

subparagraph (iii) – “(Photo-engraving)”

(2) By deleting subclause (h) of clause 8 (Terms of Apprenticeship) and substituting therefore the following:

“(h) Where the local committee is of the opinion that time served in a related or similar occupation prior to the date of application for engagement of an apprentice, should be credited to the apprentice, it may fix the term of apprenticeship.”

(3) By deleting subclause (c) of clause 10 (Proportion) and substituting therefore the following:

“(c) An employer may employ apprentices in the proportion of not more than one to every two or fraction of two journeymen employed by him.

Provided, that on application made by or through a local committee, the New Zealand Committee may determine the number of apprentices or the proportion of apprentices to journeymen, that may be employed by any employer.”

(4) By deleting from the Schedule – List of Skills, Operations, and Knowledge the following:

(i) the bracketed words “(Photo-engraving and Photolithography)” in the subheading (a)

(ii) the bracketed word “(Photolithography)” in the subheading (b)

(iii) the bracketed words “(Photo-engraving)” in the subheading (c)

2. That this order shall operate and take effect from the day of the date hereof.
