AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE WELLINGTON, TARANAKI, NELSON & MARLBOROUGH COACH AND MOTORBODY WORKERS' INDUSTRIAL UNION OF WORKERS AND URTHORN PROTECTION SERVICES LIMITED

1. The workers covered by this Agreement shall continue to be bound by the New Zealand Coach and Motor Body Builders Employees Award dated 31st March 1980, except in respect of matters dealt with in the following clauses of this agreement.

2. This Agreement shall come into effect on the 24th September 1980 and expire on the 31st January 1981.

3. WAGES: Starting Rate \$3.625 per hour \$145.00 per week After two months \$3.80 per hour \$152.00 per week (The 4 percent General Wage Increase of August 1980 is incorporated in the rates above)

4. FOOTWEAR: Gumboots will be supplied free by the Employer.

(Reimbursement of money to those who have bought their own footwear.) 5. OVERALLS: Issue of four pair of overalls per week.

6. DIRT MONEY: Dirt money will be paid at the rate of 12 cents per hour.

7. SMOKO: Fifteen minutes break will be allowed for morning and afternoon Smokos.

8. SICK PAY: Five days Sick Pay shall be available after six months employment.

9. The reason for the Term of the Agreement is that this document is the first agreement between the parties and covers a technique fairly new in the industry. Both parties feel that they would wish to have an opportunity to review the Agreement at the termination of the date stated.
