Under the Industrial Relations Act 1973

REGISTERED COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT

In the matter of the Industrial Relations Act 1973; and in the matter of the Skellerup-Isowall Limited Stationary Engine Drivers dispute of interest between Skellerup-Isowall Limited and the New Zealand Engine Drivers, Firemen, Greasers and Assistants Industrial Union of Workers.

The Arbitration Court, having before it the terms of a voluntary settlement arrived at in the above-mentioned dispute of interest and submitted or notified to the Court pursuant to the provisions of section 65 of the Industrial Relations Act 1973, hereby registers as a collective agreement the terms, conditions, and provisions set out in the form of submission or notification attached hereto and orders:

1. That the said terms, conditions, and provisions shall be binding on the parties hereto; and

2. That the said parties shall respectively do, observe, and perform every matter and thing by this collective agreement required to be done, observed, and performed, and shall not do anything in contravention of this collective agreement but shall in all respects abide by and perform it.

In witness of the registration of this collective agreement the seal of the Arbitration Court has hereto been affixed and a Judge of the Court has hereunto set his hand, this 21st day of May 1981.

STATIONARY ENGINE DRIVERS OF SKELLERUP-ISOWALL LTD –
COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT

MATTERS NOT PROVIDED FOR

1. With the exception of the matters provided for specifically herein the terms and conditions of the N.Z. Engine Drivers Boiler Attendants Firemen and Greasers Award dated 4th March 1981 shall apply for the term of this Agreement.

WAGES

2. (a) Workers holding a First Class Engine Drivers Certificate N/A cents per hour
(b) Workers holding a Second Class Engine Drivers Certificate 540 cents per hour

SERVICE ALLOWANCES

3. (a) After one years continuous service with the same employer an adult worker shall be paid an allowance of 16.00c p.h.
(b) After two years continuous service with the same employer an adult worker shall be paid a further 3.8 cents per hour making a total allowance of 19.8c p.h.
(c) After three years continuous service with the same employer an adult worker shall be paid a further 3.8 cents per hour making a total allowance of 23.6c p.h.
(d) After four years continuous service with the same employer an adult worker shall be paid a further 3.8 cents per hour making a total allowance of 27.4c p.h.
(e) After five years continuous service with the same employer an adult worker shall be paid a further 3.8 cents per hour making a total allowance of 31.2c p.h.

HOURS OF WORK

4. As provided in Clause 2 of the N.Z. Engine Drivers Boiler Attendants Firemen and Greasers Award dated 4th March 1981 except that the shift allowance be \$4.46 per shift.

EXCLUSION OF COST OF LIVING ORDERS

5. The General Wage Order of the Court of Arbitration dated 1st August 1980 and all previous General Wage Orders, Cost of Living Orders and Cost of Living Allowances, have been incorporated into the rates and payments set out in this agreement, and shall not be added to the payments shown.

TERM OF AGREEMENT

6. This agreement shall be deemed to have come into force on the 8th day of November 1980 and shall remain in force until the 8th day of November 1981.
