REGISTERED COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT

In the matter of the Industrial Relations Act 1973; and in the matter of the John McKay Film Productions Limited Actors, Actresses and Related Performers in Film, Video and Sound Programmes dispute of interest between the Actors, Variety and Performing Artists Equity of New Zealand Industrial Union of Workers and John McKay Film Productions Limited.

The Arbitration Court, having before it the terms of a voluntary settlement arrived at in the above-mentioned dispute of interest and submitted or notified to the Court pursuant to the provisions of section 65 of the Industrial Relations Act 1973, hereby registers as a collective agreement the terms, conditions, and provisions set out in the form of submission or notification attached hereto and orders:

1. That the said terms, conditions, and provisions shall be binding on the parties hereto; and
2. That the said parties shall respectively do, observe, and perform every matter and thing by this collective agreement required to be done, observed, and performed, and shall not do anything in contravention of this collective agreement but shall in all respects abide by and perform it.

In witness of the registration of this collective agreement the seal of the Arbitration Court has hereto been affixed and a Judge of the Court has hereunto set his hand, this 3rd day of June 1981.

SUBMISSION OF VOLUNTARY SETTLEMENT OF REGISTRATION

To the Registrar of the Arbitration Court:

JOHN MCKAY FILM PRODUCTIONS LTD ACTORS' ACTRESSES' & RELATED PERFORMERS' IN FILM, VIDEO AND SOUND AGREEMENT.

MATTERS NOT PROVIDED FOR

1. With the exception of the matters provided for specifically herein the terms and conditions of the New Zealand Actors' Actresses' and Related Performers' (Commercial and Film Section) Award from time to time in force shall apply.

WORKING PERIODS

2. Workers shall be called, and payments shall be computed, in units of weeks, days, and in the case of extras only, half days; except that half day calls shall fall within the time periods 8.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m., 12.00 noon to 6.00 p.m. and 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 midnight or shall be paid as a full day's call.

HOURS OF WORK

3. (a) The ordinary hours of work shall be up to eight per day within a shift of ten hours on any five days of the week.

(b) Time occupied in travel shall be deemed to be time worked.

(c) There shall be a gap of not less than 12 hours between the conclusion of work on one day and the first call of the next.

RATES OF WAGES

4. Performers shall be paid not less than the following rates of wages:

	Per Week	Per Day	Per Half Day
a. Actors.....	\$475.00	\$145.00	
b. Small part performers	\$205.00	\$ 90.00	
c. Extras	\$155.00	\$ 48.00	\$24.00

provided that:

1. Extras may be engaged en masse for crowd scenes.

2. Children under 16 years will be remunerated at the appropriate rate for the part they play.

OVERNIGHT ALLOWANCE

5. Where a performer is required to remain away from his or her normal residence overnight they shall be paid an overnight allowance of not less than \$30.00 per night in addition to the employer providing suitable accommodation.

TERM OF AGREEMENT

6. This agreement shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1981 and shall expire on the 31st day of December 1981.
