WHEREAS by section 13 (2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Arbitration Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: AND WHEREAS application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Leather, Saddlery and Canvas-goods Industry Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Leather, Saddlery and Canvas-goods Industry Apprenticeship Order dated the 27th day of April 1967, as amended on the 6th day of December 1968, the 18th day of December 1974 and the 6th day of June 1975; AND WHEREAS the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: NOW, THEREFORE, THE COURT, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, DOTH HEREBY ORDER as follows:

 THAT the said apprenticeship order shall be amended as follows: By deleting subclause (c) of clause 18 (Obligations of Employer)

2. THAT this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
