After 3 years' service increased to 33 cents per hour

After 4 years' service increased to 38 cents per hour After 5 years' service increased to 42 cents per hour After 6 years' service increased to 47 cents per hour

Crib Time Payment: Crib time shall be paid at ordinary time extra.

Meal Allowance: \$3.40. Shift Allowance: \$4.33.

Change Over Payment: \$4.26 per week.

Water Treatment and Anti Pollution Payment: \$3.42 per shift.
