NEW ZEALAND FURNITURE AND RELATED TRADES INDUSTRY —
AMENDMENT TO APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

Dated: 2.8.83

In the Arbitration Court of New Zealand in the matter of the Apprentices Act 1948; and in the matter of the New Zealand FURNITURE AND RELATED TRADES Apprenticeship Order dated the 27th day of November 1981 recorded in 81 Book of Awards 11471 as amended on the 16th day of March 1983 recorded in 83 Book of Awards 181.

WHEREAS by section 13(2) of the Apprentices Act 1948, the Arbitration Court is empowered to amend any apprenticeship order: AND WHEREAS application has been made to the Court by the New Zealand Furniture and Related Trades Apprenticeship Committee for amendment of the New Zealand Furniture and Related Trades Apprenticeship Order dated the 27th day of November 1981 as amended on the 16th day of March 1983; AND WHEREAS the Court has considered the recommendations made to it by the said Committee: NOW, THEREFORE, THE COURT, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the said Act, DOTH HEREBY ORDER as follows:

1. THAT the said apprenticeship order shall be amended in the following manner:
By deleting the words "serving an 8,000 hour term" in subclause 11.4 (Wages).
2. THAT this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
