## REGISTERED COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT

In the matter of the Industrial Relations Act 1973; and in the matter of the Stationary Engine Drivers of City Dyers and Cleaners Limited (Auckland) Dispute of Interest

between City Dyers and Cleaners Limited and the New Zealand Engine Drivers, Firemen, Greasers and Assistants Industrial Union of Workers

THE Arbitration Court, having before it the terms of a voluntary settlement arrived at in the above-mentioned dispute of interest and submitted or notified to the Court pursuant to the provisions of section 65 of the Industrial Relations Act 1973, hereby registers as a collective agreement the terms, conditions, and provisions set out in the form of submission or notification attached hereto and orders:

1. That the said terms, conditions, and provisions shall be binding on the parties hereto; and

2. That the said parties shall respectively do, observe, and perform every matter and thing by this collective agreement required to be done, observed, and performed, and shall not do anything in contravention of this collective agreement but shall in all respects abide by and perform it.

In witness of the registration of this collective agreement the seal of the Arbitration Court has hereto been affixed and a Judge of the Court has hereunto set his hand, this 26th day of March 1985.

### COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT

#### 1. MATTERS NOT PROVIDED FOR

With the exception of the matters provided for specifically herein the terms and conditions of the NZ Engine Drivers, Boiler Attendants, Firemen and Greasers Award shall apply for the term of this Agreement.

#### 2. WAGES

In recognition for qualifications held, workers holding Engine Drivers Certificates under the Boilers, Lifts and Cranes Amendment Act 1969, shall be paid, in addition to the specified hourly rate of pay, the following extra rates.

| Holder of 1st Class Certificate         | 46.00                 |
| Holder of 2nd Class Certificate         | 23.00                 |
| Holder of Boiler Attendants Certificate | 10.00                 |

The above rates are to be included in the base hourly rate in the computation of overtime.

Any worker who holds a certificate from the N.Z. Trade Certification Board that he has passed an examination in boilerhouse practice shall be paid an additional \$4.54 per week.

#### 3. SERVICES ALLOWANCES

#### 4. SICK PAY

As provided in Clause 23 of the N.Z. Engine Drivers, Boiler Attendants, Firemen and Greasers Award except that the total possible accumulation in Clause 23 (a) shall be 45 days.

#### 5. THE ECONOMIC STABILISATION (COST-OF-LIVING ALLOWANCE) REGULATIONS 1984

The rates of remuneration determined by this Collective Agreement are NOT to be increased by the application of the provisions of the Economic Stabilisation (Cost-of-Living Allowance) Regulations 1984.

#### 6. TOOL ALLOWANCE

Workers if required by the employer to use any of their own tools shall be paid \$4.66 extra per week as a tool allowance.

#### 7. TERM OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall be deemed to have come into force on the 14th day of January 1985 and shall remain in force until the 13th day of October, 1985.
