## TERMS OF VOLUNTARY SETTLEMENT UNDER SECTION 65 1.

- (a) This agreement shall apply to the parties named herein coming within the scope of the Northern Paint and Varnish and Printing Ink Workers Award in force from time to time.
- (b) The application of this agreement may be extended to any other party by the filing with the Registrar of the Arbitration Court a notice of concurrence pursuant to section 65 (6) of the Industrial Relations Act 1973.
- 2. All workers coming within the scope of this agreement shall receive a fifty (50) cents per hour increase in their basic hourly rate.
- 3. No further claims will be made on the employers prior to the next award negotiations.
- 4. The employers and the union agree to form a joint committee with an independant chairman to examine the clauses of the current dispute and to recommend changes to be incorporated in future awards. No such recommendation may be implemented before the next award.
- 5. Except as provided by this agreement the terms of conditions of the Northern Paint and Varnish and Printing Ink Workers Award in force from time to time shall apply.
- 6. This agreement shall be deemed to have come into force on the 22nd day of March 1985 and shall continue in force until the 21st day of November 1985.
