REGISTERED COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT

In the matter of the Industrial Relations Act 1973; and in the matter of the T. J. Gamble Tauranga Waterfront Cafeteria Employees Dispute of Interest

between the Northern Hotel, Hospital, Restaurant and Related Trades Employees Industrial Union of Workers and T. J. Gamble

THE Arbitration Court, having before it the terms of a voluntary settlement arrived at in the above-mentioned dispute of interest and submitted or notified to the Court pursuant to the provisions of section 65 of the Industrial Relations Act 1973, hereby registers as a collective agreement the terms, conditions, and provisions set out in the form of submission or notification attached hereto and orders:

1. That the said terms, conditions, and provisions shall be binding on the parties hereto; and

2. That the said parties shall respectively do, observe, and perform every matter and thing by this collective agreement required to be done, observed, and performed, and shall not do anything in contravention of this collective agreement but shall in all respects abide by and perform it.

In witness of the registration of this collective agreement the seal of the Arbitration Court has hereto been affixed and a Judge of the Court has hereunto set his hand, this 27th day of February 1986.

SCHEDULE**1. APPLICATION OF AGREEMENT**

This Agreement shall apply to the Northern Hotel, Hospital, Restaurant and Related Trades Employees Industrial Union of Workers, all workers employed on the Tauranga waterfront in cafeterias run on behalf of T. J. Gamble.

2. WAGES

Amend the wages clauses in the NZ Tearoom and Restaurant Employees Award by deleting the present provisions of clauses 11 (b) and (e), 12 (c) i, ii and iii and insert the following wages scale:

Kitchenhand	\$6.00 per hour
Third Cook	\$6.25 per hour
Second Cook	\$6.50 per hour
First Cook	\$7.00 per hour

3. ESCALATION CLAUSE

All remuneration specified in this agreement shall be adjusted by the same percentage movement applying to wages in the NZ Tearoom and Restaurant Employees Award whenever that document is renewed.

4. GENERAL

Except herein modified the terms of employment of all workers bound by this agreement shall be in accordance with the NZ Tearoom and Restaurant Employees Award in force from time to time.

5. TERM OF AGREEMENT

This agreement shall come into force on the 30 September 1985 and shall continue in force until the 28th day of February 1987.
