BETWEEN A. B. Bricks Limited, A. B. Pipes Limited and Crown Lynn Potteries Limited and the New Zealand Engineering, Coachbuilding, Aircraft, Motor and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers

THE Arbitration Court, having before it the terms of a voluntary settlement arrived at in the above-mentioned dispute of interest and submitted or notified to the Court pursuant to the provisions of section 65 of the Industrial Relations Act 1973, hereby registers as a collective agreement the terms, conditions, and provisions set out in the form of submission or notification attached hereto and orders:

ENGINEERS' CORE RATE AND CALL OUT AGREEMENT

This is to confirm the settlement reached on 10th December 1985, of the above agreement.

1. WAGES —

CORE TRADESMEN	—	\$8.17 per hour
FITTER'S MATE	—	\$7.01 per hour
GREASER	—	\$6.83 per hour
2. CALL OUT PAYMENT — \$39.26 per week
3. SPECIAL ALLOWANCE
All Core Tradesmen shall be paid a special allowance of 41.6 cents for each hour worked, in lieu of any other claim for welding or dirt money payments which may be applicable to the N.Z. Factory Engineers Award.
4. TERM —
