SCHEDULE

1.

APPLICATION OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall apply to the Canterbury, Hotel, Hospital, Restaurant, Club and Related Trades Employee's Industrial Union of Workers, all workers employed at the Christchurch Telgineers Cafeteria, the Christchurch Chief Post Office Cafeteria, and the Christchurch Postal Centre Cafeteria; and the employing committees being the Christchurch Telgineers Cafeteria Committee, the Christchurch Chief Post Office Cafeteria Committee, and the Christchurch Postal Centre Cafeteria Committee.

2.

WAGES

(a) The First Cook (CPO Cafeteria) shall be paid \$320.00 per week for weekly workers or \$8.00 per hour for part time or casual staff.

(b) Second Cooks shall be paid \$278.56 per week for weekly workers or \$6.964 per hour for part time or casual staff.

(c) All other workers shall be paid \$262.80 per week for weekly workers or \$6.57 per hour for part time or casual staff.

3.

GENERAL

Except as herein modified, the terms of employment of all workers bound by this agreement shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of the New Zealand Tearoom and Restaurant Employees Award in force from time to time.

4.

TERM OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1986 and shall continue in force until the 28th day of February 1987.
