Under the Industrial Relations Act 1973 REGISTERED COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT

In the matter of the Industrial Relations Act 1973; and in the matter of the Wellington Post Office Headquarters Building Cafeteria Workers dispute of interest between the Wellington District Hotel, Hospital, Restaurant, and Related Trades Employees' Industrial Union of Workers and the Wellington Post Office Headquarters Building Cafeteria Committee.

2. That the said parties shall respectively do, observe, and perform every matter and thing by this collective agreement required to be done, observed, and performed, and shall not do anything in contravention of this collective agreement but shall in all respects abide by and perform it.

SCHEDULE

APPLICATION OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall apply to the Wellington District Hotel, Hospital, Restaurant and Related Trades Employees' Industrial Union of Workers, all workers employed at the Wellington Post Office Headquarters Building Cafeteria and the Post Office Headquarters Building Cafeteria Committee.

2.

WAGES

Cooks shall be paid \$297.89 per week for weekly workers or \$7.45 per hour for part-time or casual workers.

All other workers shall be paid \$281.20 per week for weekly workers or \$7.03 an hour for part-time or casual staff.

3.

GENERAL

Except as herein modified the terms of employment for all workers bound by this agreement shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of the New Zealand Tearoom and Restaurant Employees Award in force from time to time.

4.

UNION MEMBERSHIP

If any adult person (other than a person who holds a certificate of exemption from union membership issued under section 1120 of the Industrial Relations Act 1973) who is not a member of a union of workers bound by this agreement is engaged or employed by any employer bound by this agreement, in any position or employment that is subject to the agreement, the person shall become a member of the union within 14 days after that person's engagement or, as the case may require, after this clause comes into force, and shall remain a member of the union so long as that person continues in the position or employment.

(Explanatory note in relation to expiry of union membership clause: This clause will expire on 16 December 1989 unless it is extended pursuant to section 101A of the Industrial Relations Act 1973.)

5.

TERM OF AGREEMENT

This agreement shall come into force on the 19th day of March 1987 and continue in force until the 18th day of March 1988.
