Under the Industrial Relations Act 1973
REGISTERED COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT

In the matter of the Industrial Relations Act 1973; and in the matter of the Timaru City Council Omnibus Drivers Dispute of Interest between Canterbury and Westland Drivers and their Assistants Industrial Union of Workers and the Timaru City Council.

THE Arbitration Court, having before it the terms of a voluntary settlement arrived at in the above-mentioned dispute of interest and submitted or notified to the court pursuant to the provisions of section 65 of the Industrial Relations Act 1973, hereby registers as a collective agreement the terms, conditions, and provisions set out in the form of submission or notification attached hereto and orders:

1. That the said terms, conditions, and provisions shall be binding on the parties hereto; and

2. That the said parties shall respectively do, observe, and perform every matter and thing by this collective agreement required to be done, observed, and performed, and shall not do anything in contravention of this collective agreement but shall in all respects abide by and perform it.

In witness of the registration of this collective agreement the seal of the Arbitration Court has hereto been affixed and a Judge of the Court has hereunto set his hand, this 5th day of May 1987.

**TIMARU CITY COUNCIL — OMNIBUS DRIVERS AGREEMENT
 TERMS OF VOLUNTARY COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT UNDER
 SECTION 65**

It is agreed that except as provided herein the provisions of the New Zealand (except Auckland 40 kilometre radius) Passenger Transport Drivers Award in force from time to time shall stand part of this collective agreement with respect to the omnibus drivers employed by the Timaru City Council and named in Table A hereof.

1. APPLICATION OF AGREEMENT

This agreement shall apply to omnibus drivers employed by the Timaru City Council as named in table A.

2. WAGES AND PAYMENTS

(a) The minimum rates payable to all drivers covered by this agreement shall be as follows:

	\$ Per Week
Workers with less than 12 months' current continuous service with TCC	273.98
Workers with 12 months' and less than 24 months' current continuous service with TCC.....	282.95
Workers with 24 months' and less than five years' current continuous service with TCC	287.45
Workers with five years' and less than ten years' current continuous service with TCC.....	291.95
Workers with over ten years' current continuous service with TCC	296.45

(b) An additional payment of \$10.80 per week shall be paid to the workers named in table A hereof. This payment shall not be included in the hourly rate and will be subject to the provisions of subclause (c) of clause 4 of the New Zealand (except Auckland 40 kilometre radius) Passenger Transport Drivers Award.

3. UNION MEMBERSHIP

If any adult person (other than a person who holds a certificate of exemption from union membership issued under section 112o of the Industrial Relations Act 1973) who is not a member of a union of workers bound by this agreement is engaged or employed by any employer bound by this agreement, in any position or employment that is subject to the agreement, the person shall become a member of the union within 14 days after that person's engagement or, as the case may require, after this clause comes into force, and shall remain a member of the union so long as that person continues in the position or employment.

(Explanatory note in relation to expiry of union membership clause: This clause will expire on 21 October 1989 unless it is extended pursuant to section 101A of the Industrial Relations Act 1973.)

4. **TERM OF AGREEMENT**

This agreement, insofar as the rates of remuneration are concerned, shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January 1987, and insofar as all other provisions are concerned it shall come into force on the day of the date hereof, and this agreement shall continue until 31st day of December 1987.
