**Relevant Sections:** 

*s2:* Governor may fulfil unwritten promises made with or to Maori with respect to any lands ceded by such Maori to Her Majesty.

**Commentary:** Upholds unwritten agreements with Maori that certain areas of land should have been reserved for Maori usage when blocks of land were sold. The Debates in the General Assembly suggest that there were a number of such cases and Gov. Grey wished for the agreements to be upheld to maintain good faith with Maori.
