**Relevant Sections:** 

s2: Provincial Legislatures empowered to pass Laws or Ordinances authorizing the compulsory taking of land for public works which are in comformity with the General Assembly's Land Clauses

Consolidation Act 1863.

*s6*: "Land" under this Act means only lands over which Native Title has been extinguished or set apart as Native reserves, but no authorization for compulsory taking of unextinguished Native Title land.

Commentary:

This Act follows on from the 1864 Provincial Compulsory Land Taking Act which was disallowed because it did not exempt Maori customary land. This Act does exclude Maori land where the title has

not been extinguished, but it includes Maori reserved land.
