Subject: Maori Land Court: Structures & Jurisdiction

Relevant Sections: s2: Repeals s20 Native Lands Act 1869, (time for rehearing to be granted).
 s3: Order in Council for rehearings may be granted at any time within six months after original decision. This time limit to apply to decisions made prior to as well as after the passing of this Act.

Commentary: The Native Lands Act 1869 had changed the time allowed for a rehearing to the ordered from 6 months to 3 months. During the Debates McLean says that Maori had complained that this did not allow an opportunity to obtain a rehearing so the time limit is restored to 6 months.
