- Relevant Sections:** *s5:* Governor may reserve or grant portions of land acquired under Immigration and Public Works Act 1870 to Natives where it is necessary to give effect to any agreement made between the Crown and Natives on the sale of the land.
s6: Confiscated Lands Act 1867 to continue in operation in respect of any reserves promised to Natives.
- Commentary:** As a result of the Waste Lands Administration Act 1876 confiscated lands and land purchased from Maori were under the control of Waste Lands Boards. In order to grant reserves that had been promised to Maori this Act was necessary.
