Subject:

Alienation of Maori Land

Relevant Sections:

s5: Alienations of Maori land to be invalid when contrary to equity and good conscience, when the alienation is in contravention of the trusts to which the land is subject or if the payment involved the gifting of alcohol or arms.

s6: Trust Commissioner to inquire into circumstances surrounding every alienation and ascertain whether s5 is applicable. Also to ensure that Native sellers have sufficient land left for their occupation and support.

s7: Native Assessor may be consulted.

s9: Trust Commissioner may summon witnesses.

s18: Trust Commissioner, if satisfied, shall submit certificate. No judgment to be registered without an Order in Council.

Commentary:

Major Te Wheoro suggested that Maori should assist

the Commissioner in his investigations. Section 18 provides that no judgment approved of by the Commissioner can be put into action without the consent of the Governor in Council which means that

the Government can still exercise control over alienation.

The requirement to "inquire into the circumstances attending every

alienation" (s6) was, not surprisingly, impossible in practice.
