- Relevant Sections:** s2: Definition of Crown Lands includes Native Lands ceded to Crown by Natives, or purchased or otherwise acquired from Natives, or which have become vested in HM by right of prerogative.
s220 - 226: Licenses for cutting timber and flax, removing gravel, collecting Kauri gum etc.
s227 - 236: Reserves may be made... includes Native reserves.
s247: Governor, when satisfied that any Native lands purchased by Crown are free from Native claims, shall declare lands to be Crown lands. When Native lands acquired out of moneys available for such purposes in the North Island, Governor may agree to reserve grants to Native sellers.
s248: Incomplete purchases in Thames Native Land District.
s249: Native lands leased by Crown may be sublet by the Land Board of the district.
