- Relevant Sections:**
- s25:* Governor may, after consultation with Native owners, make special regulations for securing the Titi Islands to the Natives.
 - s107:* Ellesmere Lake lands declared to be Crown lands and subject to the Act.
 - s171:* Governor may set apart village settlements for Maori exclusively.
 - ss222 - 234:* Licenses for cutting timber and flax, removing gravel, digging kauri gum etc.
 - s235:* Governor may make reserves... (6) for the use, support or education of aboriginal Natives... (9) of any land containing thermal, mineral or other springs.
 - s250:* Native lands on acquisition may be declared Crown lands when the Governor satisfied that the lands are free from all native claims and "difficulties". Portions of the land may be granted to the Native sellers.
 - s251:* Validation of leases made by Governor as agent for Natives in Thermal Springs Districts.
