Relevant Sections:

s2: Application under s26 of the Maori Land Claims Adjustment and Laws Amendment Act 1907 may be completed not withstanding the

repeal of that section.

s3: Public Trustee empowered to survey, subdivide, and lay off roads on Native Reserves vested in him, with the expenses being a

first charge on the land.

s4: Improvements by lessees under the West Coast Settlement

Reserves Act 1881 to be valued by arbitration.

s5: Governor may vest Native land (including customary land) not exceeding an area of 5 acres in Maori Land Board as site for Dairy

Factory etc.
