Reserved Land
- Relevant Sections:** s2: Native Reserves Board abolished – powers and duties vested in the Native Trustee.  
ss5 - 7: Native reserves – method of fixing rent and assignment of rent to Native Trustee.  
s8: Extension of powers of Native Trustee with respect to administration of Native estates. Charges/expenses incurred by Native Trustee shall be a first charge on the property of the deceased.  
s9: Native Trustee leasing authority for certain Tauranga lands in Schedule.
- Commentary:** The Native Affairs Minister refers to this Amendment as purely machinery to enable the Native Trustee to fully carry out duties.
