Relevant Sections:

s2: Native land defined as land held by Natives under their

customs and usages.

s10: ss22 - 23 do not apply to the taking of Native land

for Public Work.

s15: Power to take any area of land (including Native land) required for forest plantation purposes, recreation grounds, agricultural show grounds etc. Proviso that no Native land to be taken without the

consent of the Native Minister.

s30: Taking land for road.

*s*32: Minister or local authority may enter into agreements to take land required for Public works. In this case compensation to be paid

may be agreed upon or determined under Part III of this Act.



Public Works Act 1928 continued

ss42 - 101: Compensation

s42: All persons having any interest in any lands taken under this Act for Public Works shall be entitled to full compensation. *s48(2):* Compensation for lands taken out of any Native reserve may be made by the Native Trustee.

ss102 - 106: Native Lands

s102: Notwithstanding any law in force, any Native land may be taken for public work.

s104: Compensation for taking of Native land to be ascertained by the NLCt in all cases.

s107: Powers of entry on land for survey purposes.

ss251 - 259: Defence works.

Commentary: The Debates indicate this Act is a Consolidation.
