Adjustment 1930 *continued***

s14: Upon application of Native Minister the NLCt may readjust boundaries between Native land if satisfied that it is in the public interest or the interests of the owners. By consent, Crown or European land may be included in such a scheme of subdivision.

s15: Authorising NLCt to declare trusts regarding land or moneys set aside for the benefit of Natives where it is expedient to change the object of the trust.

s16: Authorising and validating Crown leases of Native township lands.

s17: Duty of Board to protect Native burial places.

Commentary: To facilitate consolidation schemes where the land is tied up with outstanding rates or survey liabilities, this Act provides (s13) that the Crown can pay the debts then apportion and acquire land in lieu of payment from the owners.
