- Commentary:** Effects a “final settlement” of claims concerning the Kemp purchase of the Ngaitahu Block with a payment of £300,000 to the Ngaitahu Trust Board. Money to be paid at rate of £10,000 p.a. for 30 years. The Act follows the recommendation of the 1921 Native Land Commission in its report of Kemp’s South Island Purchase. Until the passing of the 1946 Ngaitahu Trust Board Act the money was paid to, and held by, the Native Trustee.
