land near Opotiki. £20,000 to be paid to the Native Trustee for the general benefit of members of Whakatohea Tribe and descendants.

Commentary:

This claim had been reported on by the 1921 Native Land

Commission which found the "the penalty paid by Whakatohea,

great as was their offence, was heavier than their desserts".

The 1928 Sim Commission Report recommended an annual payment at £800 p.a. which is now capitalised to £20,000, which is to be paid

to the Native Trustee for the purchase of land for settlement

and development.
