Type of Legislation: Public
Subject: Govt Admin Specific to Maori/Maori Land
- Relevant Sections:** *s14:* Any Inspector may enter upon Maori land and take measures as may be necessary to clear the land of noxious weeds.
s15: The amount of all costs paid by the Crown in respect of any Maori land may be recovered from the occupier.
- Commentary:** This Act is mainly a consolidation but it now gives the Crown the right to recover the costs of clearing noxious weeds from Maori land in the same way as unpaid rates can be recovered.
