- Relevant Sections:** s3: Where any lessee is entitled to a renewal of his lease, the Maori Trustee may execute a memorandum of extension of the lease.
- Commentary:** The Act concerns leases under the Maori Reserves Act 1882, Westland and Nelson Maori Reserves Act 1887, and the Maori Townships Act 1910. The leases have a perpetual right of renewal and this Act substitutes a Memorandum of Extension by the Maori Trustee as the means to document renewals, regardless of whether the lease was originally granted by the Maori Trustee.
