s7: Leases granted by the Proprietors of Mangakino Township Incorporated shall not be subject to the limitation on term imposed by *s235* Maori Affairs Act 1953.
s8: Disposal by Maori Trustee of balance of sum reserved for costs in the Aorangi claim.
- Commentary:** According to the Debates section 7 relates to Mangakino leases that the Maori owners wanted to make perpetually renewable for churches, hospitals etc.
