# CULTURAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF NEW ZEALAND AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ITALY

The Government of New Zealand and the Government of the Republic of Italy,

Desiring to reinforce the friendly relations between the two countries and to further mutual understanding and knowledge through the development of their cultural relations,

Have agreed as follows:

#### ARTICLE I

Each Government shall endeavour to encourage the understanding and teaching of the language, literature, culture and history of the other country in its schools, universities and other educational institutions.

# ARTICLE II

Each Government shall endeavour to encourage cooperation and exchanges in the cultural field between universities and other educational and cultural institutions and organisations of the two countries.

# ARTICLE III

Each Government shall facilitate the exchange of books, publications and films in literary, artistic, cultural and educational fields.

#### ARTICLE IV

Each Government shall facilitate the organisation in its territory of exhibitions and cultural events relating to the cultural and artistic life of the other country.

#### ARTICLE V

Each Government shall facilitate exchanges and cooperation between the youth and youth organisations of the two countries.

## ARTICLE VI

The two Governments shall consider the possibility of convening periodic meetings between representatives from the two countries to examine the implementation of this Agreement.

## ARTICLE VII

The provisions of this Agreement shall have effect for the Cook Islands, Niue and Tokelau after the expiration of one month from the date of notification by the Government of New Zealand to the Government of Italy that they shall be applied to these territories.

## ARTICLE VIII

This Agreement shall come into force on the date of signature and shall be of unlimited duration. Either Government may at any time denounce it in writing through diplomatic channels. The denunciation shall take effect six months after receipt of the notification by the other Government.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, duly authorised thereto by their respective Governments, have signed this Agreement.
