> I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of New Zealand and the Government of Western Samoa for Air Services between and beyond their Respective Territories, signed at Apia on 23 June 1978, as amended by an Exchange of Notes concluded at Apia on 2 July 1984, and as further amended by an Exchange of Notes at Apia on 31 August 1990, (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") and, to propose that, in accordance with Article 15, the Agreement be amended as follows:

(a) The Cook Islands shall cease to be regarded as a part of the territory of New Zealand for the purposes of the Agreement. To that end Article 1 (1) (e) shall be amended to read as follows;

"the term "territory" in relation to a State means the land areas and territorial waters adjacent thereto under the sovereignty of that State and in the case of New Zealand also includes Tokelau;" (b) the Schedule annexed to the Agreement shall be replaced with the Schedule set out in the Annex to this Note.

If the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of Western Samoa I have the honour to suggest that this Note together with your reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement amending the Agreement on Air Services between our two Governments which shall be deemed to have entered into force on 23 June 1993 when the Agreement between the Government of the Independent State of Western Samoa and the Government of the Cook Islands for Air Services Between and Beyond their Respective Territories entered into force.

Excellency,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of Your Excellency's Note dated 12 November 1993 which reads as follows:

"I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of New Zealand and the Government of Western Samoa for Air Services between and beyond their Respective Territories, signed at Apia on 23 June 1978, as amended by an Exchange of Notes concluded at Apia on 2 July 1984, and as further amended by an Exchange of Notes at Apia on 31 August 1990, (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") and, to propose that, in accordance with Article 15, the Agreement be amended as follows:

(a) The Cook Islands shall cease to be regarded as a part of the territory of New Zealand for the purposes of the Agreement.
To that end Article 1 (1) (e) shall be amended to read as follows;

"the term "territory" in relation to a State means the land areas and territorial waters adjacent thereto under the sovereignty of that State and in the case of New Zealand also includes Tokelau;" (b) the Schedule annexed to the Agreement shall be replaced with the Schedule set out in the Annex to this Note.

If the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of Western Samoa I have the honour to suggest that this Note together with your reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement amending the Agreement on Air Services between our two Governments which shall be deemed to have entered into force on 23 June 1993 when the Agreement between the Government of the Independent State of Western Samoa and the Government of the Cook Islands for Air Services Between and Beyond their Respective Territories entered into force.

Accept, Sir, the assurances of my highest consideration."

I have the honour to confirm that the Government of Western Samoa accepts the proposal contained in your Note and that your Note and this reply shall therefore constitute an Agreement between our Governments with effect from the date of this reply.

I avail myself of this opportunity to extend to Your Excellency the assurances of my highest consideration.
