2. This regulation shall be read together with and form part of the Financial Instructions and Allowance Regulations for the New Zealand Military Forces, 1925 (hereinafter called "the principal regulations").

3. Regulation 71 of the principal regulations as heretofore from time to time amended, is revoked and the following

substituted to take effect on and from the 25th June, 1939:-

71. There shall be paid at the rate hereinafter provided a travelling-allowance which shall include meals and porterage. Such allowance shall be paid only on defined absence from residence or headquarters, and not while the member is under canvas or with troops who are rationed:—
