At the Government House at Wellington, this 20th day of September, 1939.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by Order in Council dated the sixteenth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, and published in the *Gazette* of the eighth day of the following month, at page 9, William Buchanan, of Okuru (hereinafter called "the licensee"), was, in pursuance of the provisions of the Harbours Act, 1923 (hereinafter called "the said Act"), authorized to use and occupy part of the foreshore at Okuru River, as shown on plan marked M.D. 7517, and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington, in order to maintain thereon a jetty:

And whereas it is desirable to prescribe the dues and rates which shall be charged and taken for the use of the said jetty:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon him by the said Act, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby prescribe that the dues and rates set forth in the Schedule hereto shall be charged and taken by the licensee for the use of the said jetty.
