### RESOLUTION.

THE following regulations were laid before the members of the Rotorua and Bay of Plenty Hunt Club at a meeting held on the 23rd day of September, 1939, at 3.15 p.m., with a recommendation by the Chairman of such Club, Dr. H. Bertram, that the same be passed at once with a view to their approval by His Excellency the Governor-General in pursuance of the Gaming Act, 1908, section 33. Dr. H. Bertram, the Chairman of such Club, and the meeting moved, and Mr. J. Smyth seconded, and it was resolved that such regulations should be adopted and that the Chairman and Secretary be authorized to sign the same in authentication

The following are the regulations referred to :-THE ROTORUA AND BAY OF PLENTY HUNT CLUB.

#### REGULATIONS.

# (Under the Gaming Act, 1908.)

(Under the Gaming Act, 1908.) In pursuance and exercise of the powers in that behalf contained in section 33 of the Gaming Act, 1908, and of all other powers and authorities it enabling in that behalf the Rotorua and Bay of Plenty Hunt Club, a racing club within the meaning of the said Act (hereinafter referred ro as "the said Club"), doth hereby make the following regulations controlling the admission of persons to that part of the Gate Pa Racecourse situated in the district of Tauranga and known as the Bay of Plenty Racing Club's Racecourse, while the said recourse is used or occupied by the said club for race said racecourse is used or occupied by the said club for race meetings.

1. These regulations shall come into force on the date of the same being published in the New Zealand Gazette. 2. In these regulations the words "bookmaker," racing club," and "race meeting" shall have the meanings ascribed to those terms respectively by section 2 of the Gaming Act, 1000 1908.

3. The following persons shall be and are hereby excluded from the racecourse above described while the same is used or occupied by the said club for a race meeting, namely :--

- (a) Bookmakers.
  (b) Bookmakers' clerks, bookmakers' assistants, and bookmakers' agents.
- (c) All persons under disqualification inflicted by any racing or trotting club in the Dominion of New Zealand, the Commonwealth of Australia, or elsewhere if affiliated to the New Zealand Racing Con-ference, or the New Zealand Trotting Conference, or the New Zealand Trotting Association.
- (d) Common prostitutes and persons who habitually con-sort with thieves or persons who have no lawful visible means of support.
- (e) Professional tipsters, persons convicted of house-breaking or pocket-picking, forgery, uttering or possessing counterfeit coin, theft, false pretences, receiving stolen goods, mischief, assault, or any offence or crime of any kind under the Crimes Act, 1009, and the did wind divergence of the construction. 1908, and also idle and disorderly persons, rogues, and vagabonds, and incorrigible rogues convicted under the Police Offences Act, 1908, and persons convicted of an offence under the Gaming Act, 1908.

Provided always that the Executive Committee appointed by the New Zealand Racing Conference, upon being satisfied by evidence as to character and otherwise that any person who, by reason of any conviction, comes within the scope of this regulation, should have relief from the effect thereof, may grant exemption to any such person, and may at any time revoke any such exemption without notice to such person, and without assigning any reason for such revocation. The foregoing regulations of the Rotorua and Bay of Plenty Hunt Club were made and passed by such club on the 23rd day of September, 1939, and signed by the Chairman and September. and Secretary.
