RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

Kurow Water-supply Supplementary Loan, 1939, £200.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Waitaki County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of two hundred pounds (£200), authorized to be raised by the Waitaki County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purposes of providing a high-pressure water-supply for the Township of Kurow and a certain defined area contiguous thereto, the said Waitaki County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of two-fifths of one penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property of the special rating area comprising the Township of Kurow, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the first day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of five (5) years or until the loan is fully paid off. The said special rate of two-fifths of one penny is in addition to the special rate of 2-29 pence made and levied in respect of the original loan of three thousand pounds."
