RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Waipa County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £2,000, authorized to be raised by the Waipa County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of providing the Waipa County Council's proportion of the cost of constructing a bridge (together with the approaches thereto) over the Waikato River at the “Narrows” on the Rukuhia-Tamahere Road, the said Waipa County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three two-hundredths of a penny (3/200d.) in the pound upon the rateable (unimproved) value of all rateable property of the whole of the County of Waipa, and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the first day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five (25) years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
