WHEREAS the Scenery Preservation Board, constituted pursuant to the Scenery Preservation Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), has recommended that the State forest lands described in the Schedule hereto that the State forest lands described in the Schedule hereto should be permanently reserved for scenic purposes: And whereas the Minister in Charge of Scenery Preservation and Commissioner of State Forests has also, pursuant to section fifty-five of the Statutes Amendment Act, 1938, recommended that the said lands should be declared scenic reserves, and it is expedient to give effect to such recommendations:

Now, therefore, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and experies of the powers conferred by section six

suance and exercise of the powers conferred by section six of the said Act and the said section fifty-five of the Statutes Amendment Act, 1938, do hereby proclaim and declare that the State forest lands described in the Schedule hereto shall be seenic reserves under the said Act, and subject to the provisions thereof.
