

Notice of Intention to take Land in Block XIV, Puniu Survey District, for the Purposes of a Road.

Kaitaia Drainage Area.—Notice of Intention to make and levy General Rates.

NOTICE is hereby given that it is intended, pursuant to the Swamp Drainage Act, 1915, and its amendments, to make and levy, on the unimproved value of all land within the Kaitaia Town District Subdivision of the Kaitaia Drainage Area constituted under the said Act, the general rate described in the First Schedule hereto, and on the unimproved value of all land in the Subdivision of the Kaitaia Drainage Area outside the Kaitaia Town District the general rates described in the Second Schedule, such respective rates being for the purpose of meeting maintenance-costs for the period from the 1st April, 1939, to the 31st March, 1940.

The amount of the general rates, together with the annually recurring special rates already made and levied, will be payable in one sum on the 15th November, 1939.

The valuation roll and the rate-book of the district will be open for inspection at the office of the Collector of Rates, Chief Drainage Engineer's Office, Room 45, First Floor, Government Buildings, Customs Street West, Auckland, and copies of same may be inspected at the Office of the Land Drainage Engineer, Kaitaia, at all times at which those offices are open for the transaction of public business.

TOWN SUBDIVISION.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

RURAL SUBDIVISION.

Class A: On the unimproved value of all land classified as Class A by the persons appointed to classify lands under section 3 of the Swamp Drainage Amendment Act, 1928, twelvence and fifty-two one-hundredths of a penny (12.52d.) in the pound.

Class B: On the unimproved value of all land so classified as Class B, fourpence and thirty-eight one-hundredths of a penny (4.38d.) in the pound.

Class C: On the unimproved value of all land so classified as Class C, one penny and eighty-eight one-hundredths of a penny (1.88d.) in the pound.
